Pursuant to the authority granted by the Governor through Executive Order No. 61, I am expanding the scope provided by recently issued Directive 16-01 to include those impacted by the November 29<sup>th</sup> severe weather in Southeast Tennessee. This inclusion is consistent with the Governor's Executive Order No. 61 and is being issued in response to increased reports of damage from severe weather unrelated to wildfires, as well as requests from the industry for clarification.

As a reminder, this Directive is not intended to address circumstances involving fraud or material misrepresentation or any other reason unrelated to hardships created by the severe weather.
